



M C Bank – Hometown Spirit Scholarship Application – 2023

M C Bank will grant four \$1,000 “Hometown Spirit Scholarships”. Invited participants include graduating high school seniors from Berwick High, Central Catholic High, Morgan City High, and Patterson High. The winning scholarship recipients will receive a one-time cash award to be awarded after high school graduation.

Selection Criteria:

- Essay (65% of score): submit an essay on “What makes my hometown special”. Essay must be typed, double-spaced, and at least 500 words. Please do not include names or other identifiable information in the essay, as we make the scholarship applications anonymous to our internal selection committee.
- Extracurricular Activities and Awards (20% of score): both school and community activities
- Grades/ACT (15% of score): attach a transcript signed by Principal or Guidance Counselor

If you do not receive an email confirming receipt of your application within 72 hours, please resubmit or talk with your guidance counselor. Guidance Counselors at each school will be notified by M C Bank of the winning scholarship recipients.
